\$145,975,118

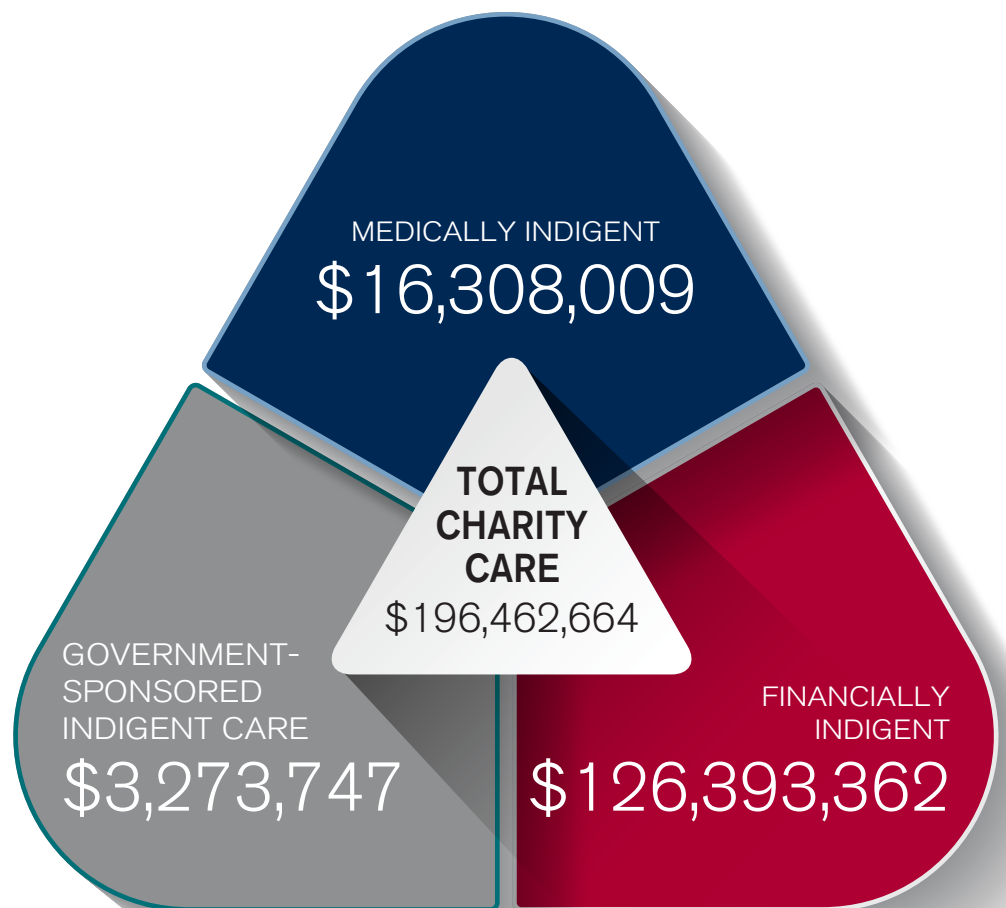

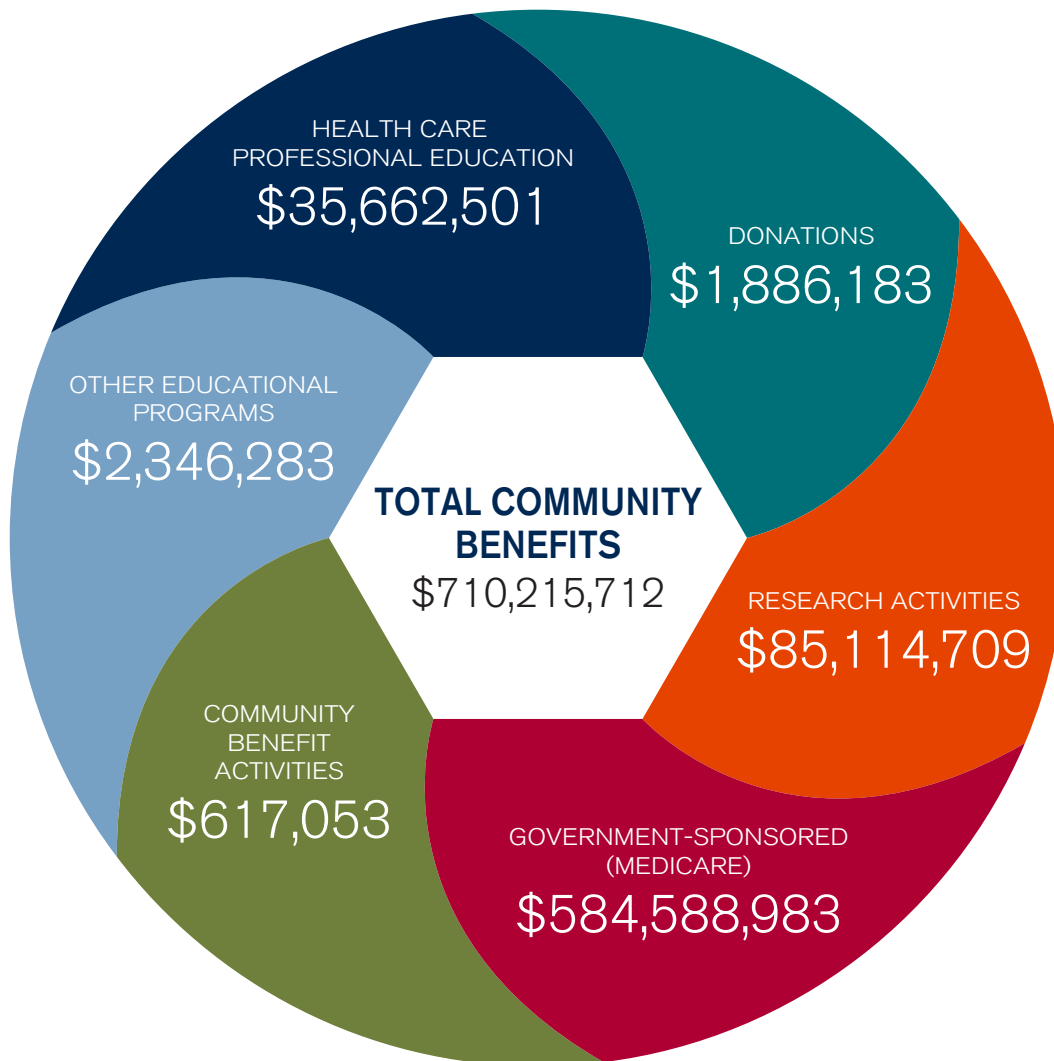
