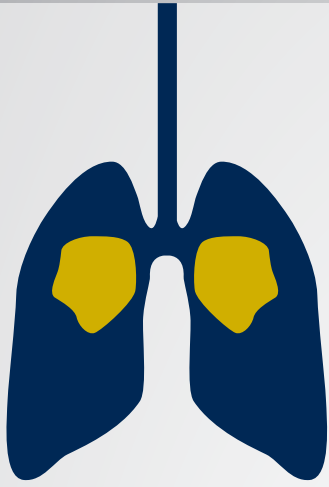

LUNG CANCER SCREENING PROGRAM

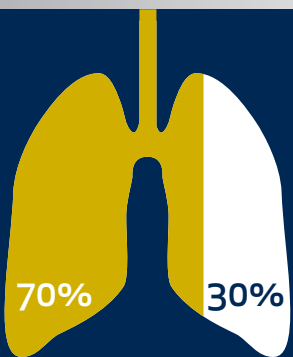
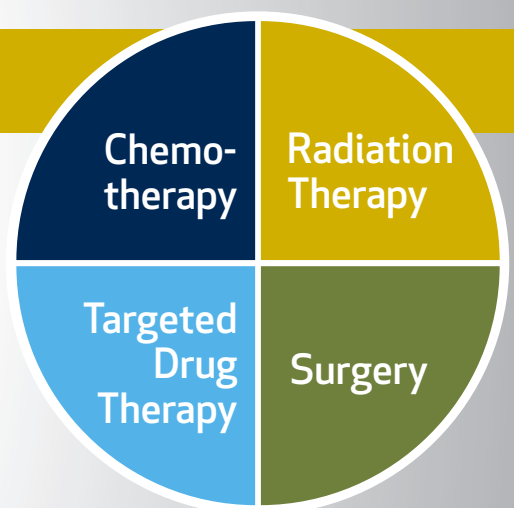
- Program includes:
 - ▶ Annual low-dose CT scans
 - ▶ Access to tobacco cessation programs
 - ▶ Consultations from health care providers
 - ▶ Lung cancer support group

- Eligible patients include:
 - ▶ Current or former smoker age 50 or older
 - ▶ Have smoked equivalent one pack of cigarettes a day for at least 20 years
 - ▶ Lung cancer survivors are also considered



TREATMENT OPTIONS

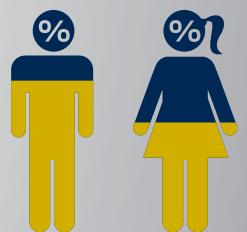
Early detection and multidisciplinary care is the best way to fight lung cancer.



70% of cancer is from smoking
30% of cancer has no identifiable cause

Risk factors: smoking, secondhand smoke, radon, asbestos, diesel exhaust, air pollution

Each year **more men** are diagnosed with lung cancer, but more women are living with the disease.
