

2018 Houston Methodist Grants: Frequently Asked Questions

FAQ:

Is my organization able to apply for both the Community Benefits and the Mental Health Innovation grants?

Yes, we welcome organizations to apply for both the CB grant and the MHI grant. Requests must be for different projects, as the CB grant is not intended for mental health initiatives.

Is my organization able to apply for operational support?

Yes, organizations are able to apply for operational/ overhead support, as well as program support, through the Community Benefits grant.

My organization has several innovative mental health projects planned. Could we submit requests for all of them through the MHI grant application?

Only one project may be submitted for consideration for the MHI grant. The project must be for a specific program or project aimed to enhance behavioral health. Other projects that are not focused on behavioral health may be submitted through the CB grant application.

Where can I find the grant applications?

Both the CB grant and the MHI grant can be accessed through the online [grant portal](#).

What are the steps to completing either one, or both, of the grants?

On the portal homepage you will find instructions for logging in. Once you are logged in, you will complete the following:

- 1) An eligibility screening quiz to determine that your organization is eligible to apply
- 2) An organizational overview to provide detailed information about your organization
- 3) Selection of grant type applying for (Community Benefits, Mental Health Innovation, or both Community Benefits and Mental Health Innovation)
- 4) Program specific application (will include two applications to complete if you have selected to apply for both the CB and MHI grants)
