This annual Integrated Health Education And Leadership (I HEAL) program is designed to increase practitioner awareness and discuss evidence-based management of urological disorders. Learners will be able to recognize and counsel patients in both surgical and nonsurgical approaches to urological diseases and disorders. This event includes an opportunity to observe in aligned clinical areas.

Family Practice Physicians, Internal Medicine Physicians, Hospitalists, Urologists, Neurologists, Gynecologists, Emergency Department Physicians, Advanced Practice Providers, Nurses, and other health care practitioners interested in the care of challenging urological patients seen in the hospital setting.

Program Objectives:

Clinical Observership Objectives

- Develop an understanding of the Houston Methodist Structure and ICARE values which propel the institution's professional success and patient-centered culture
- Acquire insight into the various roles involved in team-based care across the care continuum for patients with neuro-urological diseases and urological emergencies
- Observe day to day clinical operations to acquire insight to be used as a basis to formulate related clinical questions
- Gain exposure to the use of therapies and processes to recognize, understand, and manage patients with urological disorders
- Review processes in place for comprehensive education of patient and family regarding care.
- Participate with Grand Rounds, Journal Clubs, etc.

Below the Beltline 2018 Conference Objectives

- Describe new advances and technologies in the care of patients with urological disorders
- Discuss the multidisciplinary team approach to patients with urological disorders
- List surgical, nonsurgical and alternative therapy strategies to improve morbidity, decrease poor outcomes and enhance quality of life in patients with urological disorders
- Participate with Grand Rounds, Journal Clubs, etc.

Program Outline:

Learners will be assigned rotations with physicians or clinical experts within the Houston Methodist Urology Department or the most aligned clinical area. They will spend a total of 3 days observing leading up to the *Below the Beltline: Neuro-Urology and Neurological Emergencies Conference*. The Global Education and Training team will consult with each participant and evaluate their CV to determine the best observation assignment.

- **Day 1:** Welcome Orientation and Tour of HMH Facility
- **Day 1 to 3:** Clinical Observation
- **Day 4:** Neuro-Urology and Urological Emergencies Conference at Houston Methodist Research Institute
