

#### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

#### Q: Should everyone have a screening test?

**A:** No. Screenings are beneficial for men between 40 and 65 and women between 45 and 70 or if you are considered intermediate risk. Risk factors include family history, smoking, high cholesterol, high blood pressure and diabetes. This is a screening exam to assist in detecting potential diseases.

# Q: If I have a known heart condition, can I still get these tests?

**A:** The Heart Scan and Heart Scan Plus are not necessary for those who have coronary artery disease, heart stents of any kind or have had coronary bypass surgery. For these patients, we recommend an evaluation by a cardiologist.

#### Q: How can I pay for these tests?

A: The prices listed reflect the cash pay price and include both the test and evaluation of the results. While insurance may provide coverage, the prices may vary and a doctor's referral may be required for scans and screenings. If using insurance, please obtain an order from your physician to ensure appropriate scheduling and verification. Medicare will not cover the cost of these tests.

#### Q: How long will the test take?

A: The heart scan takes approximately 15 minutes. The Vascular Screening and the Vascular Age Screening (CIMT) each take approximately 30 minutes. The complete Heart Scan Plus will take approximately one hour.

# Q: Why should I have my screenings at Houston Methodist?

**A:** Your results will be processed in an accredited lab and evaluated by either a cardiologist, a vascular surgeon or a sub-specialized radiologist. Your results will be sent to your physician and/or you within seven business days. We suggest you share the results with your primary care physician or cardiologist.

#### HEART SCAN \$140

Calcium Score Using a CT scanner, this tests for calcium buildup of plaque on the walls of the arteries. It is used to detect coronary artery disease and, if present, can determine the severity.

#### VASCULAR AGE SCREENING (CIMT) \$120

Using ultrasound, the thickness of the arteries is measured to produce a risk assessment that estimates the vascular age of your arteries.

Blood vessels are also checked for blockages.

#### VASCULAR SCREENING \$120

Carotid Artery Screening | Blood vessels are checked for blockages using ultrasound.

Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm Screening Using ultrasound, this test looks at the abdominal aorta and checks for thinning or ballooning, either of which could suggest a potential rupture.

Peripheral Artery Disease (PAD) Screening
Blood pressure cuffs are placed on the
ankles to evaluate blood flow in the legs.

#### HEART SCAN PLUS \$205

This combination package includes the Heart Scan and the Vascular Screening.

To self-refer, candidates must be male 40-65 or female 45-70 and have one of the following risk factors: diabetes, current smoker, obesity, family history, cholesterol greater than 160/LDL and/or blood pressure greater than 140/90.
