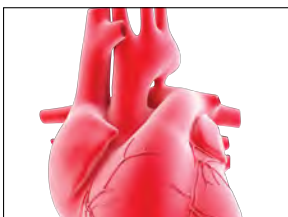

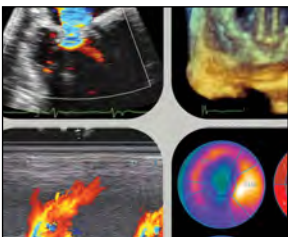

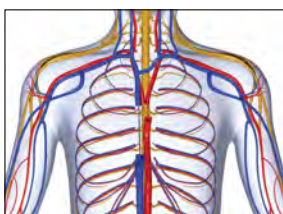
THIRD ANNUAL | **ACHD Fellows Training**

Aortic Root and Aortic Valve Assessment and Surgical Perspectives in ACHD is the theme of this year's specialized course for ACHD Fellows, offering an in-depth exploration of aortic root and aortic valve pathology in adults with congenital heart disease. Through expert-led didactic sessions and hands-on simulation, participants gain practical insight into surgical anatomy, advanced imaging interpretation, and contemporary operative strategies. The course emphasizes decision-making across valve-sparing and root-replacement techniques, including the Ross, David, and Manouguian/Bo Yang operations, as well as emerging percutaneous approaches. Fellows engage directly with faculty, enhancing individualized instruction and technical understanding.

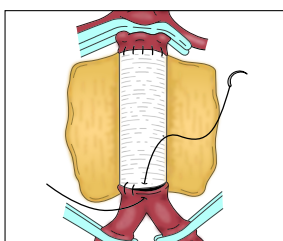
